

Roosevelt Aquatic Center Facility Reservation Agreement

I understand that with reserving the Roosevelt Aquatic Center:

1. I will pay the final fee at the night of my reservation.
2. The 50.00 deposit fee is refundable if:
 - (a) The aquatic center staff cancels the reservation due to weather or mechanical failure of the pool system.
 - (b) The party that made the reservation completes the cleanup checklist and no damage or mess has been made.
3. I may reschedule my reservation, free of additional costs, as long as it is done at least 2 weeks in advance.
4. All facility rules will be followed by my party as defined below.
5. Reservations start at the time specified toward the top of this waiver.
 - (a) I am responsible for cleaning up during my reservation.
 - (b) The pool, party rooms, and deck areas will be cleared by no more than 15 minutes after the end time of my reservation as listed above.
6. No open flames are allowed at or in the facility.
7. No lifejackets are allowed on the inflatable obstacle course
8. Roosevelt City Corporation reserves the right to amend these regulations and/or adopt new regulations as it may deem necessary.
9. Roosevelt City Corporation/Roosevelt Aquatic Center reserves the right to alter operating hours in consideration of schedule changes, special events, programs, weather or mechanical problems related to the pool.

27. Any child under three years old, any child not toilet trained, and anyone who lacks control of defecation shall wear a water resistant swim diaper and waterproof swimwear. Swim diapers and waterproof swimwear shall have waist and leg openings fitted such that they are in contact with the waist or leg around the entire circumference.
28. Diapers shall be changed only in restrooms or changing stations and shall not be changed at poolside. The person or persons who change the diaper must wash their hands thoroughly with soap before returning to the pool. The diapered person must undergo a cleansing shower before returning to the pool.

Diving Area Rules

29. Only one person on the board at a time, and no swimming in front of the diving boards.
30. Only one bounce on the diving board.
31. Exit the board straight. After surfacing, swim directly to the side of the pool.
32. Wait for the previous diver to reach the side before stepping up on the ladder.
33. Non-swimmers are not permitted in the deep end and may not jump off the board into the arms of someone in the water.
34. Goggles or masks shall not be worn when entering the pool from the diving board.
35. No personal flotation device allowed in the deep end of the pool.

Inflatable Obstacle Course Rules

I understand and will adhere to the following rules:

36. Those playing on the track must be able to swim without a lifejacket
37. Only 1 person gets on at a time, the user can climb onto the 1st platform while in water or hop onto the 1st platform from the deck
38. Next person in line can start when the person in front is past the first large piece (usually balance pole)
39. If you jump or fall off the track, you must swim to the side closest to you and restart back at the end of the line
40. Do not hang on or play with the bungee straps
41. Do not pull at or swim underneath the inflatables
42. No lifejackets or goggles allowed on inflatable track
43. No diving boards allowed when the inflatable track is in the water
44. No rough play activities allowed
45. I understand that if I do not follow one or more of the rules listed above, that I can be expelled from the facility and if during a reservation, my reservation can be cancelled without a refund

Roosevelt Aquatic Center Party Room Reservation Agreement

1. The fee for both party rooms in a reservation cover up to 25 people and the fee for one of the two party rooms in a reservation cover up to 12 people. Any additional people in the party need to pay the daily admission fee, unless the additional patrons have a Roosevelt Aquatic Center membership.
2. The 50.00 deposit fee is refundable if:
 - a. The Aquatic Center staff cancels the reservation due to weather or mechanical failure of the pool system.
 - b. The party that made the reservation completes the cleanup checklist and no damage or mess has been made.
3. I may reschedule my reservation free of additional cost, as long as it is done at least 2 weeks in advance.
4. All facility rules will be followed by my party as defined below.
5. My group will be out of the party rooms by the end of my defined reservation time.
 - a. I am responsible for cleaning up during my reservation.
6. No open flames are allowed at or in the facility.
7. Roosevelt City Corporation reserves the right to amend these regulations and/or adopt new regulations as it may deem necessary.
8. Roosevelt City Corporation/Roosevelt Aquatic Center reserves the right to alter operating hours in consideration of schedule changes, special events, programs, weather or mechanical problems related to the pool.

1. All membership sales are final and must be paid in full.
 - (a.) No refunds will be given after the first use of a purchased membership.
 - (b.) A recurring membership can be canceled at the end of the time period for when that given membership expires.
 - a. Must notify the aquatics staff at least 7 days before the expiration date to cancel.
2. Family memberships are only set up for immediate household families except:
 - a. When one individual that is 16 or older that is not a part of the household is included to supervise the household kids 9 years of age and under
3. Adult Couple and Senior Couple memberships are set up for your immediate household only.
4. Any child two years old or younger will be admitted free, but he/she must be accompanied by someone who is at least 16 years of age or older.
5. All memberships are non-transferable. Changes in a membership must be reported to the Roosevelt Aquatic Center staff for a change to occur.
6. All persons must check in for themselves at the pool.
7. All guests will be charged the current daily admission price.

 - i. Ex: 10.00 refund when cancelling in the first month
 - ii. Ex: 5.00 refund when cancelling in the second month
 - b. Refunds are taken by the Customer Service Associate Supervisor or Aquatics Manager
2. Only Roosevelt City Aquatic Center combination locks are allowed on the lockers
3. I will only use the locker that I have been assigned by an aquatics employee
4. The day my locker rental expires, I will clean out my locker and return the lock to the front desk
5. I give permission for the Roosevelt Aquatics staff to clean out my locker if I neglect to clean out my locker the day my locker rental expires
 - a. All personal belongings collected after cleaning the locker will be placed in the lost and found
6. Roosevelt City Corporation reserves the right to amend these regulations and/or adopt new regulations as it may deem necessary
